



Why We Support Dave Hill and the Trade Union and Socialist Coalition

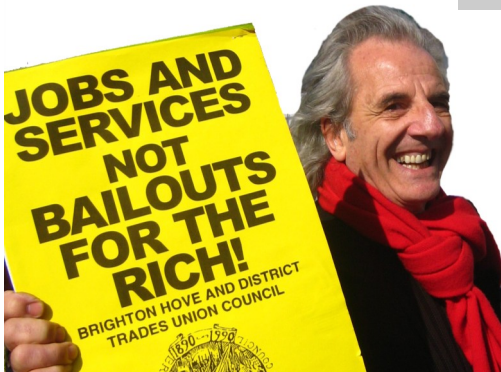
