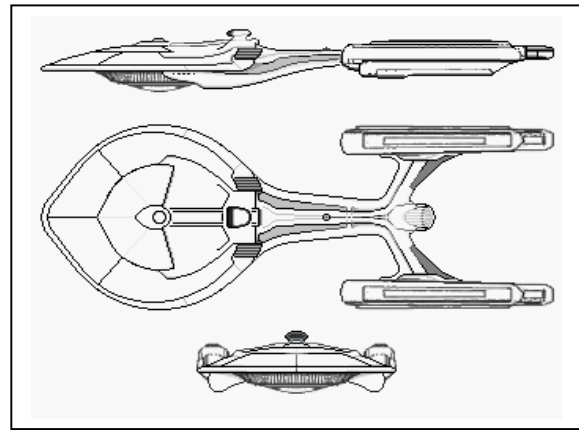

Notes:

The *Dreamrunner* is a class built to suit the needs of a powerful Orion Family. In Orion terms, it is only a freight runner that has been given the weapons it needs to accomplish its job. The Avasse Family was tired: tired of cargos that didn't get through and old freighters in constant need of repair. They were tired of having to buy scouts for scouting, freighters for hauling freight, and couriers for high speed luxury runs or V.I.P.'s- tired of single purpose ships that let business opportunities slip through their fingers. Worst of all, they were tired of smiling across the negotiation table at the leaders of other families who had most likely destroyed a freighter of theirs.

The A Model *Dreamrunner* was built by Orinco Shipbuilders of Rigel. A total of 25 A Models were built before production was halted. Once Orinco finished the A Models at Rigel they began to produce the B Models at an undisclosed location at a rate of 6 per year. These ships would rarely see Federation space, but there are reports of them being used in the KNZ, the Triangle and within Klingon space. Oddly, Starfleet Intelligence has found no trace of them being used within Orion space, but they are certain that many of the ships are based there.

Avasse Proprietary Systems, an Orion Company owned by the Avasse Family, operates all of the ships constructed to date. Both the A and B Models incorporate an advanced sensor suite, powerful tractor beams, durable shields, and one multi-role, docked shuttle. The B Model has additional systems intended for hostile environments.

Of the 25 A Models, all but 2 are in service-one due, reportedly, to a dry-docking accident, while the other was destroyed by a Tellarite vessel. The disposition of the 40 odd B Models is uncertain (as is the case with most information on the B Models), but there are unconfirmed reports that one was lost in a confrontation with an AOFW destroyer. At about that same time, an AOFW *Baker* Class was said to have undergone an emergency dry-docking for repairs at their Morning Garden Facility. Outside of that, occasional rumors persist of vessels encountering *Dreamrunners* in the Triangle and disappearing.

The Avasse (Ah-voss) Company slogan is "We'll get what you need" - and the *Dreamrunner* is helping them to get it there.
