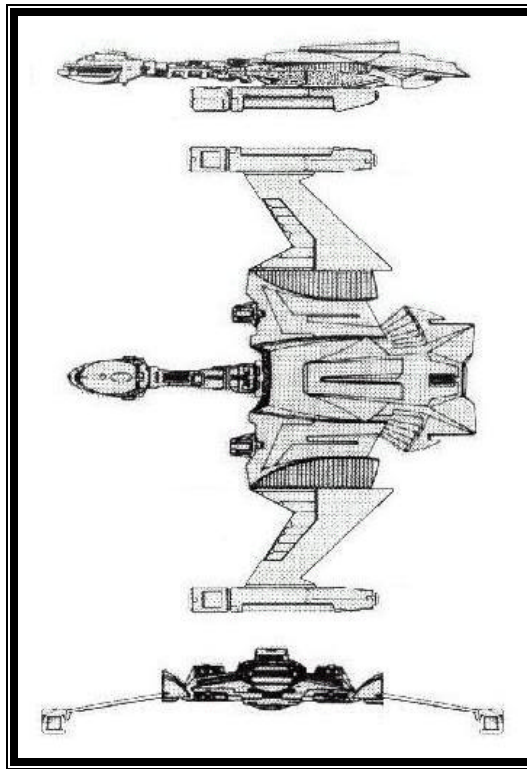
**Notes:**

In mid 2270's, the Romulan High Command started receiving detailed intelligence reports of new Federation starships that were coming out of the Starfleet yards. These new ships got the Romulans worried. As a result of this, they decided it was time to increase the inventory of ships in the fleet by adopting a new thinking on future ship construction. One of the first destroyer designs off the line was the T-25 Tagor Vastam (Deathwing) class. The T-25 was designed for simplicity and rapid construction with ability for easy to refit. This was the big plus to the ship. Originally the T-25 design called for all the weapons to be mounted on the wings, but was ruled it out after computer testing of design revealed it to be a liability. Upon redesign of the weapon systems, it was determined that the T-25 had a good amount of firepower for its class. In 2280, the first T-25 was launched and shortly after a successful trail run was placed into mass production.

The Type 1 version saw action on both the Klingon and Federation borders. The Federation at one point confused it with the T-10 Bright One, thinking it was a major upgrade to the T-10 class. When they sent in a couple of destroyers to gather more detailed scans of a possible new T-10 type variant, but were soon proven wrong. They had not anticipated a discovery of a new Romulan destroyer type that was apparently all ready produced in fairly large numbers and equipped with a cloaking device.

After an incident in late 2291 with a Klingon D-21 it was decided to upgrade the Deathwing temporarily until the Romulans can study the D-21 and create there own version of the ship. In 2292 the Type 2 was introduced. Originally the Type 2 was only going to be a minor upgrade but soon turned into a major upgrade. Every major system was upgraded including computer, warp engines, shields, and weapon systems. In response to many of the crew suggestions, the Type 2 was equipped RPL-3 plasma weapon.

After 23 years of the Type 1 and Type 2 serving side by side, the high command had decided it was time to upgrade the ship class once again. In 2315 it was decided to upgrade the T-25 to the new Type 3 specifications. When the Klingons heard of the new upgrade, they sent in two D-18 and four D-14 destroyers to get their hands on one. What they did not know was the new Type 3 was equipped with two Romulan Super Disrupters. Also what did not help was the fact they were going to try to get one right after the Romulans had completed war games. The Klingons did not realize at first was they were met by 3 T-25s and one V-26 Firewing. This resulted in a major victory for the Romulans and a slaughter for the Klingons. The Romulans had followed the motto of the ship. "If attack, attack close and never let up". The Klingons had lost all of the ships except for two, which got away. The Type 3 is expected to see a lot of action in its service life. It has been rumored that the Romulans are going to try to make a light cruiser of this version to help the Firewing in patrol the boarders of the Romulan Empire. If this rumor is true it could shift the power in key sectors along the Neutral Zone between the Romulans and the Federation.
