Distinguishing Physical Characteristics:

Admiral Cartwright is of medium height, standing 5'10" (1.78m), gaunt, with closely-cropped black hair and a dark complexion. When expressing silent disapprovals, his brow crests like a tidal wave, which earned him the nickname "Storm" while at Star Fleet Academy, where he held the Academy Middleweight Sonic Boxing Title for over two years.

Kenneth J. Cartwright wanted to go into space since he was a child, having grown up in the shadows of the Kennedy Space Center, where many of Terra's early efforts at space exploration were centered. His desires lit a fire in his eyes which have never been extinguished, even though he is now Chief of Star Fleet Operations, having succeeded Admiral Heihachiro Nogura in the storm over the failure of Operation Dixie.

His most distinguished tour of duty occurred aboard the *USS Kongo*, where he was the Commanding Officer for six years before being promoted to SFHQ.

PERSONALITY:

Motivations/Desires/Goals:

Cartwright is an ardent supporter (perhaps one of the most crucial) of the Warp 10 Navy. He understands its tremendous potential in preserving the balance of power between the UFP, the Klingons and the Romulans by utilizing the UFP's clear technological superiority to the utmost. However, he is not above negotiation. Even though he cannot understand some of the motives which drives the Klingons, at least he is willing to sit down and talk. This has even earned the grudging respect (at least on the surface) of the Klingon Ambassador to the UFP, Kiltarc zantai-Neygebh.

Manner:

Cartwright is no quitter; if there is any problem in any situation, he will not stop until a solution is found. He expects his subordinates to do the same.

Special Knowledges/Powers:

Flag Admiral Cartwright has a SECLAR Rating of 8.

Distinguishing Physical Characteristics:

Fergus is 5'8" (1.73m) tall, with white hair and a full beard without sideburns.

Brief Personal History:

Birthplace: Daraniss, Daran V.

The son of a merchant captain employed by one of the many corporations on Daran V, Fergus graduated from Darannol University at the top of his class in 1/72, and sought employment in the civil service, where he served 10 years as an Administrator of Civil Affairs. Upon achieving his doctorate (in 1/82) he sought and was elected to a political office: Representative to the Assembly of Worlds.

Fergus held this post for over 30 years, building a strong constituency both inside the Assembly and among his fellow Daranians. He was elected to sit on the council in 2/14, and succeeded outgoing President James Abelmare of Terra in 2/19. He is currently serving his second term as Council President.

PERSONALITY

Motivations/Desires/Goals:

Being a native of a major freeport world located close to the Romulan frontier, Fergus understands the meaning of vigilance very well. He is also the champion of free trade, which was how he gained notoriety in the Assembly.

Fergus is a master at maintaining order or restoring it, depending on the situation, even when the Klingon Ambassador makes an occasional appearance before the council. Though he feels slightly nauseous when the ambassador appears, Fergus allows him to speak even when everyone else demands that he shut up. After all, even a Klingon Ambassador has the right to free speech in the Federation's Council Chambers.

Manner:

Fergus' forceful, yet deft eloquence allows him to maintain control of a Council which has grown very anti-Klingon in the last few years.

Special Knowledges/Powers:

President Alistair Fergus has a SECLAR Rating of 9.

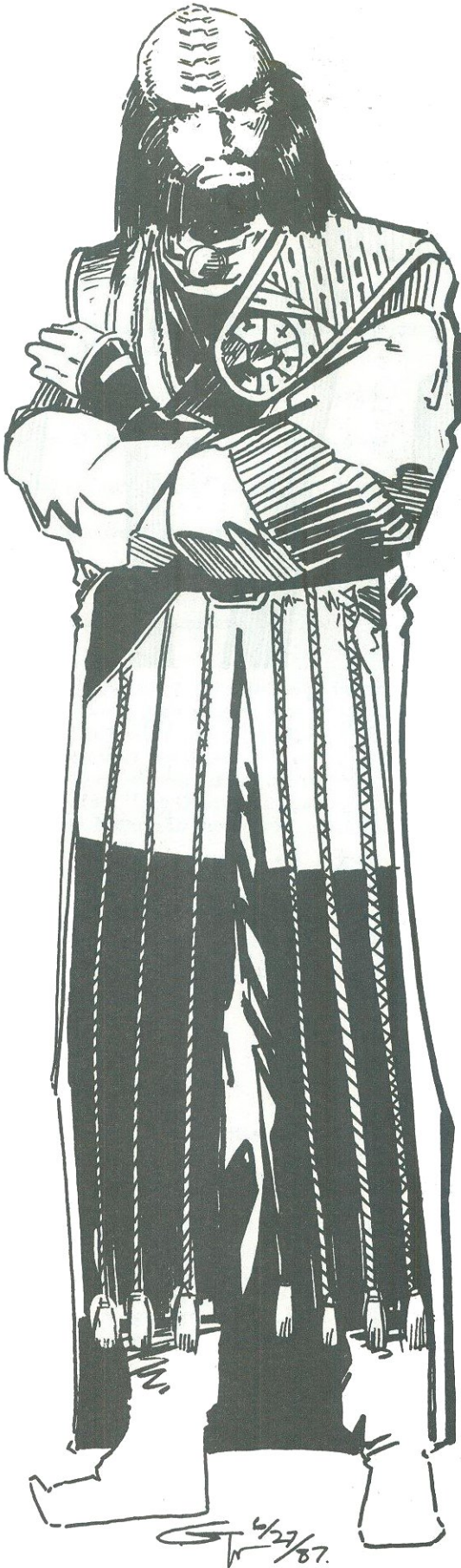

Distinguishing Physical Characteristics:

Kiltarc's face looks exceedingly drawn-out for a Klingon of the Imperial Race. He also has distinguished bags under his eyes. The Ambassador is in very good physical condition for a Klingon his age.

Brief Personal History (As obtained from Star Fleet Intelligence Command, Klingon Sector Intelligence):

Birthplace: Aval, Klinzhai, Klingon Empire.

Kiltarc's career has very unusual beginnings, even for a Klingon. When his original family line was ordered terminated by the Imperial Council, he was secretly spared from execution by the Emperor himself, since he felt that Kiltarc was too loyal an officer to be destroyed along with his family line. At this time, he was serving his first term as a Naval Officer along the Romulan border.

As part of the plan to save Kiltarc's life, the Emperor pulled him from Naval service, granted him a new family line, and sent him into the Klingon Diplomatic Corps, where he has served the Empire faithfully for over half his life. He is credited with negotiating all three Technological Exchange Treaties with the Romulan Star Empire. In 2/21, he was appointed Ambassador to the UFP.

PERSONALITY:

Motivations/Desires/Goals:

Kiltarc knows why he was sent to Terra: to obtain information on the Genesis Device. He was also ordered by the Emperor himself to inform the UFP of the coming signs of war. He feels very uncomfortable among Humans and Vulcans in particular.

Manner:

Ambassador Kiltarc has no trouble keeping a false front with the "reeking peace-lovers" of the Federation. Like any diplomat, he has to!

Distinguishing Physical Characteristics:

Dr. Taylor, despite her upbringing in the 20th Century, is very feminine, although she still “bums around” in blue jeans (which, fortunately for her, are still popular in the 23rd Century) every once in awhile. She is 5’ 6” (1.68m), with light brown hair and blue eyes.

Brief Personal History:

Birthplace: Carmel-by-the-Sea, California, USA, Terra.

Technically speaking, Dr. Gillian Taylor is 266 years of age (her date of birth is -1/5604.17). Though she is not ashamed of this fact, for all intents and purposes she acknowledges her birthdate as 1/9204.17. She is one of the very few Federation citizens with an official “dual birthdate” in her citizenship records.

Taylor has been interested in whales since she was 20 years of age, when during a summer vacation cruise to Acapulco, she spotted a school of blue whales in migration. When she returned to college at UCLA, she changed her major to marine biology. She graduated *magna cum laude* in -1/78, and while employed at her first and only job outside college, the Cetacean Institute, she obtained her doctorate in -1/84. Dr. Taylor was then appointed Assistant Director of the Institute.



Ironically enough, the Cetacean Institute stands today as a Federation Landmark, both as a silent reminder of Humanity's past treatment of the marine environment, and as a tribute to the heroic efforts Terra undertook to save the whales after the horrible Eugenics Wars.

Dr. Taylor currently is aboard the Bader-Class Scout U.S.S. *Tombaugh*, one of the three ships involved in the Sagan Award, as a student observer. Although she is already regarded as THE expert in cetaceans, she literally has to go back to school to learn what happened to Terra and sciences since she left the 20th Century. Fortunately, recordings of her favorite musicians, Bruce Springsteen, Genesis, and Waylon Jennings, survived the Eugenics Wars. This has helped her to adjust to her new life.

PERSONALITY:

Motivations/Desires/Goals:

Gillian Taylor believed, in her own way, Admiral Kirk's story about wanting to help the whales. She couldn't fully

comprehend why until the moment she was beamed aboard the *Bounty*. She elected to leave the 20th Century and travel with Admiral Kirk because she had no family other than the whales. Her parents and only brother were killed in an automobile accident when she was 16.

Taylor knows she has a lot of catching up to do...about 236 years' worth. She knows George and Gracie are at peace, free from the hunters which plagued the 20th Century, and she is, too, for this reason. This is her new life, and now the stars are open to her.

Manner:

Although easy-going and friendly, Taylor has always said one thing about herself: she is a "sucker for hard cases." This facet of her being has led her to make her decisions, and, eventually, the choice to leave Old Terra behind for the future.
