

# Can you spare 100 seconds?

Many parents drop or pick up their children and then make three point turns or u-turns, and drive back past the valet area. That creates a dangerous situation as parents and children cross the street to go from car to school and back. It takes just 100 seconds to go around the block. So if you turn around after drop-off or pick-up instead of driving around the block, you really aren't saving that much time. And for those few seconds gained, you are adding unnecessary risk to an already chaotic situation. Please give a hundred seconds.



## Safety Tips **PLEASE:**

- Proceed with caution and at a slow speed when pedestrians are present in and near the roadways
- Be extra careful during drop-off and pick-up
- Obey all stop signs and yield to pedestrians in crosswalks
- Follow the above traffic pattern (green arrows) whenever possible
- DO NOT make three-point turns into driveways and do not make mid-block u-turns.
