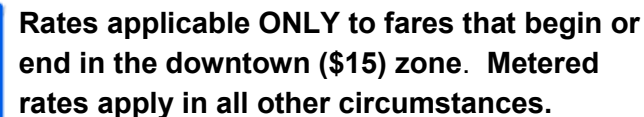




Applicable to fares with an origin or destination in the downtown zone ONLY

Rates effective Thursday, February 2-Monday, February 6, 2012 ONLY



Maximum occupancy of four passengers per sedan and six passengers per van.

For multi-zone destination fares, each stop shall pay the applicable flat rate.

Additional out-of-county rates originating or ending in the downtown zone:

\$50: Greenwood

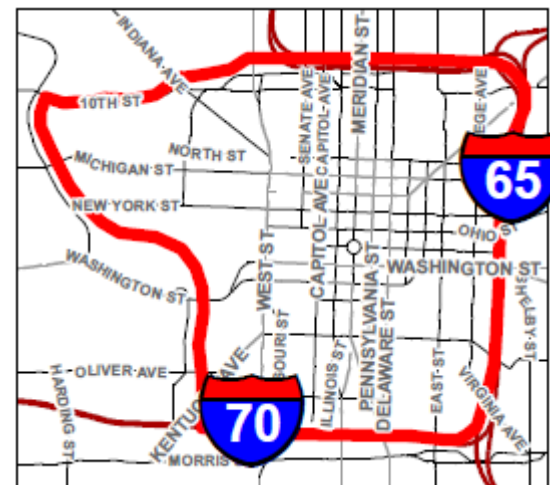
\$60: Zionsville, Carmel, Fishers

\$65: Brownsburg, Plainfield, Greenfield

\$75: Noblesville

About the Flat Rate Fare Map

What dates are these rates applicable?

The special event rates are only valid from Thursday, February 2nd (beginning at 12:01 a.m.) to Monday, February 6th (ending at midnight).

What areas does the rate map apply to?

The rates are **ONLY** valid for trips originating or ending in the downtown zone. The metered fare will be used for all other trips.

What happens if I am traveling to an area not listed on this map?

Any trip that originates or ends beyond the area shown on the flat rate map will be billed using the taximeter.

Can I request the driver to use the meter rather than the flat fare?

NO. If your trip originates or ends in the downtown area and you are traveling to or from a zone shown on the map, you must pay the flat fare.

Is the fare amount per passenger or per vehicle?

The fare shown on the map is a per vehicle fare. You may have up to four passengers per car or up to six passengers per van.

Does the flat fare apply to me if I am traveling from one zone to another zone, but not downtown?

NO. The fare only applies to trips originating or ending downtown. All other trips will be billed according to the taximeter.

My friend and I are sharing a cab but traveling to different zones. What should I expect?

To ensure that the City can adequately handle the increased volume of visitors, you can expect to be charged the destination zone rate for each fare. Multiple stops are still considered a single trip and the fares do not reset at each individual stop. For example: If a fare originates at Lucas Oil Stadium (downtown zone) and requests to go to Circle Center Mall (downtown zone) and then to Carmel, the following fare is due: \$15 and \$60.

Can I pay with credit or debit card?

YES. All licensed taxicab drivers are required to accept credit or debit card payments.

I am traveling from Fishers to the Super Celebration Site in Broad Ripple Village. Will I pay a flat rate?

NO. The fare only applies to trips originating or ending downtown. All other trips will be billed according to the taximeter.
