

## Presentation Guidelines

Presentation contents must include the following but not limited to:

<b>CONTENTS:</b>	
<b>1.</b>	<b>Define if the invention is a process or product.</b>
<b>2.</b>	<b>Is the invention a solution to the problem in the field of technology?</b>
<b>3.</b>	<b>Is the invention new? Justification must be given for proof of invention novelty.</b>
<b>4.</b>	<b>Explain the inventive step accordingly or if the field of technology is not common.</b>
<b>5.</b>	<b>Indicate that the invention has industrial application and it can be part of the mass market.</b>
<b>6.</b>	<b>State the approximate value of the invention upon commercialization (e.g. how much will it cost in the mass market or how much is the proposed licensing fee.)</b>
<b>7.</b>	<b>List the exact date and venue of conferences, exhibitions, journals, etc. that have been published and exhibited.</b>
<b>8.</b>	<b>Is this a joint venture with others (industry or institutions) or otherwise?</b>
