- Do you or your club have access to a high repeater site (over 250Ft+ Commercial Tower or Commercial Rooftop 10+ Story bldg.) with internet access?
- Are you or your club interested in converting an existing high site 70cm (440 MHz) repeater over to DMR?
- Special discounts and even possible repeater equipment donations are available to help with the expansion of DMR in the State of Georgia

### Restrictions:

- You must show an existing or new SERA repeater coordinated 440 repeater pair with DMR digital mode listed.
- No Garage, Home Repeater, or low level repeater sites
- Repeater Sites in the State of Georgia Only
- Applies to a Motorola XPR8400, MTR3000 or SLR5700 440 MHz Repeaters only
- Agree to not resell any hardware for at least 3 years if donated
- Place discounted Repeater on the air operating on the agreed upon site for a period of at least 3 years
- Repeater must be on the air for no less than a period of 3 years if discounted
- Repeater site must have internet access available and the repeater must be connected to the K4USD or Georgia DMR Cbridge
- Repeater must operate in the digital only mode and not mixed mode (analog/digital)
- Discounts and donations are at the sole discretion of North Georgia Communications and depend upon location and coverage area of repeater
