Masters Degree Fellowships in Forestry Conservation, Natural Resources Management and related disciplines at US Universities

The US Agency for International Development (USAID) is funding master's degree opportunities for 20 highly qualified Indonesian candidates to study forestry conservation, natural resources management and related disciplines in the United States.

The program will be administered by the Center for International Forestry Research (CIFOR). CIFOR will match qualified candidates with participating US university partners, and will assist candidates with various aspects of the university application process.

Highly qualified candidates are invited to apply now for admission in **September 2016**. Deadline for applications: **30 November 2015**.

Applications will open in **April 2016** for admissions in **September 2017**.

- Research thesis to be completed in Yr 2
- Opportunities to carry out field research in Indonesia, linked to CIFOR projects
- Tuition fees, living and travel expenses covered
- 1 year English language study course prior to Master's program (*for admissions in September 2017 only*)

Qualifications

- Bachelors degree in relevant disciplines including but not limited to: forestry, agroforestry, biology, soil conservation and management, wildlife management and biodiversity conservation, forest economics, business administration, anthropology, sociology and gender studies
- Secure a score on the TOEFL English language exam as required by the admitting partner university
- Secure a score on the US Graduate Record Exam (GRE) as required by the admitting partner university
- Prior work experience in forestry, natural resources management and related fields desirable
