## Apply for MEXT e3 scholarship



Application for enrollment with MEXT scholarship offered by our program starts with the screening and selection for the scholarship. Nominated applicants will be then asked to submit additional documents to complete the admission procedure. Enrollment with this scholarship is possible once a year, from Autumn semester starting in October. Next intake is October 2017 (Application deadline: November 15, 2016).

### Application documents (2017)

The following documents should be sent to the program office by post by the deadline:

#### 1. e3 application form

Please write the names of 2 laboratories you are interested in. If you consider a possibility to do research in a different laboratory please tick "I agree to be considered for acceptance by different supervisor/laboratory."

If you consider to enroll even if you were not awarded MEXT e3 scholarship please check the respective box and inform our office regarding the details: desired enrollment date, your funding plan etc.

#### 2. Research proposal

Please prepare well thought out research proposal(s). If you are applying for two laboratories with different research scope, please prepare two proposals. Please use the following format and follow the guidance.

#### 3. Official academic transcripts or an attested copy for every graduated /expected to graduate university program (Bachelor's course, Master's course)

If you study is on-going, the transcript should include the latest records available by the time of your application.

#### 4. Photocopy of diploma for each graduated university program or graduation/expected graduation certificate (original or attested copy)

If your study is on-going, please prepare expected graduation certificate, or certificate of enrollment which shows the expected date of course completion.

#### 5. 2 recommendation letters

One of the letters shall be provided by your supervisor in the most recently graduated/expected to graduate school. You may use the format provided by e3 or any other format.

It should clearly show the publication details.

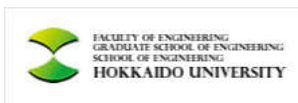
**9. A certificate of ranking**
