Harry Potter Christmas Tree Baubles



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Average size of baubles 5 ½ inches high

Materials needed

DK or equivalent yarn in the following colours

Flesh

Red

Black

Dark brown

Fun fur and eyelash yarn in the following colours

Black

Grey/silver

White

Black mohair yarn (if you do not have this

DK can be used and brushed up with a teasing or wire brush)

Florist or thick fuse wire for the glasses (these can be embroidered on if you prefer)

8 x 5mm white beads

2 x 8 mm white beads (these are for the eyes or alternatively you can embroider them on or use felt)

Metallic gold crochet cotton (alternatively use yellow yarn)

Stuffing

Brown powder eye shadow and red blusher (or slightly moistened coloured pencils)

Tiny scrap of brown felt for Dobby's eyes

Acrylic paints or felt pens for eyes

Abbreviations

k = knit

p = purl

Ss = stocking stitch – one row knit one row purl

Inc1 = make a new stitch by knitting into front and back of next stitch (do **not** make new stitch by picking up strand in between two stitches, or any other method or your stitch count will be wrong)

tog = together

st/sts = stitch/stitches

Basic head and hat

Using flesh, Cast on 7sts

Next row, (inc1) in every st to end (14sts)

Next row, p

Next row, (inc1) in every st to end (28sts)

Starting with a purl row

Ss 14 rows

Break with flesh and join in white eyelash

PURL 2 rows

Break with eyelash and join in red

Starting with a purl row

Ss 5 rows

Next row, k2tog, k to last 2sts, k2tog

(26sts)

Next row, purl

Repeat last two rows once more (24sts)

Next row, k2tog, k to last 2 sts, k2tog

Next row, p2tog, p to last 2 sts, p2tog

Repeat last two rows until 4 sts remain

Ss 2 rows

Next row, k2tog twice

Draw yarn through remaining 2 sts and fasten off.

Basic Ears

Using flesh

Cast on 10sts

Knit 1 row

Draw yarn through all 10sts and fasten off.

Basic nose

Using flesh

Cast on 10sts

Ss 4 rows

Draw yarn through all 10sts and fasten off.

Basic eyes

Please see the photos at the end of the pattern for step by step painting guide.

Basic hanger

Using metallic crochet cotton or yellow yarn make a crochet chain or twisted cord of 8 inches in length.

To make up

The seam will be centre back.

Starting at the tip of the hat, join row ends, stop at end of hat to stuff or getting the stuffing right to the top may prove a little difficult. Continue joining row ends of the face, stuffing as you go. Sew a running stitch around the base and draw up tightly, sew in end.

Join row ends of nose and sew to the face following the particular picture for correct positioning.

Sew ears in place on each side of the head, again following the particular picture for correct positioning. NOTE: Severus Snape does have ears but they are hidden under his hair, omit these if you wish.

Attach the hanger to the top of the hat.

Harry



Make basic head, hat, ears, and nose.

Hair

Using black eyelash

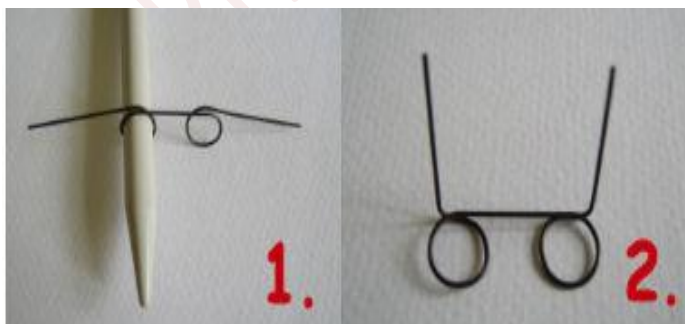
Cast on 16sts

Ss 6 rows

Cast on 10sts, then cast off ALL the stitches

Glasses

Using florist or thick fuse wire and a 10mm needle or round pencil of similar size, wrap the wire around as shown in the picture 1 below, then bend them as shown in pictures 2.



Eyes

Using 5mm beads follow the basic instructions for the eyes (found at end of the pattern) using green paint or felt pen. Sew eyes through the head positioning as in the Harry picture.

Using the 10 cast off stitches of the hair as a fringe, wrap the hair around the head just below the white eyelash and secure. Embroider a mouth as shown in the Harry picture.

Using blusher give Harry some rosy cheeks, using brown eye shadow, colour the inside of the ears and give him two small nostrils.

Push the glasses into the knitting and position over the eyes.

Dumbledore



Make basic head, hat, nose, and ears.

Hair

Using grey/silver fun fur

Cast on 16sts

Ss 14 rows

Cast off

Beard

Using grey/silver fun fur

Cast on 4sts

Ss 2 rows

Next row, inc1 at beginning and end of the row (6sts)

Next row, p

Repeat last 2 rows until you have 18sts ending on a k row.

Starting with a p row

Ss 3 rows

Cast off

Glasses

Using florist or thick fuse wire, and the 10mm needle or pencil, wrap the wire only **half** way around the needle and bend as in the picture below. Push the stems into the knitting at each side of **top of the nose**



Using 5mm beads follow the basic instructions for the eyes (found at end of the pattern) using brown paint or felt pen. Sew eyes through the head positioning as in the Dumbledore picture.

Using the cast off edge, sew the hair around the head, from the back of ear to the back of ear. Sew the beard from the bottom front of ear to bottom front of the other ear. Add a stitch in matching yarn in front of each ear from hair to beard to form sideburns. Using a strand of matching yarn, sew two stitches from under the nose down into the beard to form a moustache. Using matching yarn, do a long stitch over each eye to form eyebrows.

Using blusher and brown eye shadow, as on Harry, put on the finishing touches.

Hagrid



Ss 4 rows

Cast off

FLUFF HAIR AND BEARD UP SLIGHTLY
BEFORE SEWING ON.

Using 5mm beads follow the basic
instructions for eyes (at end of the
pattern) using brown paint or felt pen.
Sew eyes through the head positioning as
in the Hagrid picture.

Sew on hair as in Harry

Sew on beard as in Dumbledore

Sew sideburns, moustache, and eyebrows
as in Dumbledore.

Using blusher and brown eye shadow, as
on Harry, put on the finishing touches.

Make basic head, hat, nose, and ears.

Hair

Using dark brown DK and black mohair
together

Cast on 16sts

Ss 10 rows

Cast on 10sts, then cast off ALL the
stitches

Beard

Using dark brown DK and black mohair
together

Cast on 6sts

Next row, inc1 at beginning and end of the
row (8sts)

Next row, p

Next row, inc1 at beginning and end of the
row (10sts)

Draw the yarn through these 2sts and fasten off

Severus



Make basic head, hat, and ears.

Hair

Using black mohair

Cast on 28sts

Ss 14 rows

Cast on 2sts at the beginning of the next two rows

Cast off

BRUSH UP SLIGHTLY BEFORE SEWING ON

Nose

Using flesh

Cast on 8sts

Ss 4 rows

Next row, (k2tog) 4 times (4sts)

Next row, p

Next row, (k2tog) twice (2sts)

Next row, p

Using 5mm beads follow the basic instructions (at end of the pattern) for eyes using brown paint or felt pen. Sew eyes through the head positioning as in the Severus picture.

Using the cast off edge of the hair sew around the head starting at the centre of the forehead and ending back at the centre of the forehead.

Sew a couple of extra strands of the black mohair from one side of the head to hang over the face to give Severus his straggly hair style. Sew on two eyebrows also using mohair.

Using brown eye shadow, darken under the eyes and high light cheek bones.

Using a single strand of black DK, embroider a mouth as shown in the Severus picture.

Dobby



Make basic head and hat

Ears

RIGHT EAR

Using flesh

Cast on 12sts

Starting with a knit row

Ss 4 rows

Next row, k2tog, k to end (11sts)

Next row, p to last 2 sts, p2tog (10sts)

Next row, k2tog, k to last 2 sts, k2tog (8sts)

Next row, p2tog, p4, p2tog (6sts)

Next row, k2tog, k2, k2tog (4sts)

Next row, p2tog twice (2sts)

Draw yarn through these 2sts and fasten off

LEFT EAR

Using Flesh

Cast on 12sts

Starting with a knit row

Ss 4 rows

Next row, k to last 2 sts, k2tog (11sts)

Next row, p2tog, p to end (10sts)

Next row, k2tog, k to last 2 sts, k2tog (8sts)

Next row, p2tog, p4, p2tog (6sts)

Next row, k2tog, k2, k2tog (4sts)

Next row, p2tog twice (2sts)

Draw yarn through these 2sts and fasten off

Nose

Using flesh

Cast on 10sts

Ss 4 rows

Next row, k3, (k2tog) twice, k3 (8sts)

Next row, p

Next row, k2, (k2tog) twice, k2 (6sts)

Ss 3 rows

Next row, (k2tog) three times (3sts)

Draw the yarn through these 3sts

Fold each ear in half and over sew the row ends, sew to the head positioning as in the Dobby picture.

Starting from the tip of the nose, join the row ends of the nose and sew to the face positioning as in the Dobby picture.

Using 8mm beads follow the basic instructions for eyes (found at the end of the pattern) using green flecked with a little yellow if you can manage it.

Cut out two 14mm circles of brown felt and make a hole in the centre of each, sew the eyes to the head positioning as in the Dobby picture **BUT** put the felt circles **behind** the eye before you do and sew through the holes you made.

Embroider a mouth using a single strand of black DK as in the Dobby picture.

Give Dobby a pair of rosy cheeks.

Basic eye painting instructions

I threaded the eyes through a needle and pushed them into a piece of Blue Tac to hold them in place while you decorate them.
