Conference Overview

The conference will present plenary speakers from the Philippines and abroad who are experts in their respective fields of education, research and development from various disciplines including: Social Sciences; Science and Technology; Education and Curriculum; and, Business, Administration, and Management. A keynote speaker is also invited to share his insights with the participants. Round table discussions and parallel sessions of research presentations shall also be included in the conference.

The sessions are meant to put together the brains and personas behind various researches and ideas so as to share, impart, review and perhaps improve more the outputs, the visions and the insights of the participants concerning their respective areas of specialization.



Conference Objectives

7. to gain a broader viewpoint and wider outlook through paper presentations in the fields of Education and Curriculum; Science and Technology; Social Sciences; Business Management and Administration.

2. Science and Technology
3. Education and Curriculum
4. Business, Administration, and Management



Participants:

Attendees could either be participants or paper presenters (oral or poster). Participants and/or presenters are teachers from private and public elementary and high schools; faculty members and personnel from HEIs; and graduate students. Participants or paper presenters will have to pay the same amount of registration fee. However, if paper presenters have more than one paper to present either orally or poster, they will have to register separately for each paper.

Participants can attend the entire conference, interact with paper presenters and keynote as well as plenary speakers while paper presenters may present their papers either orally or through poster during the parallel sessions on the second day. The tracks where the papers may be presented are the following:

1. Social Sciences / Language and Communication
2. Science and Technology;
3. Education and Curriculum; and,
4. Business, Administration, and Management.

The poster presenters will be provided their area of poster presentation according also to the different tracks mentioned above.

Cultural/Fellowship Night and Networking

On February 8, 2014, a Cultural/Fellowship Night shall be held in order to give chance to the participants for networking and get acquainted with one another. Cocktails shall be served during the event.

Attire

During the opening ceremony/program, participants are encouraged to wear either their best Filipiniana attire or their regional attire for Filipino participants and national costumes for foreign participants.
