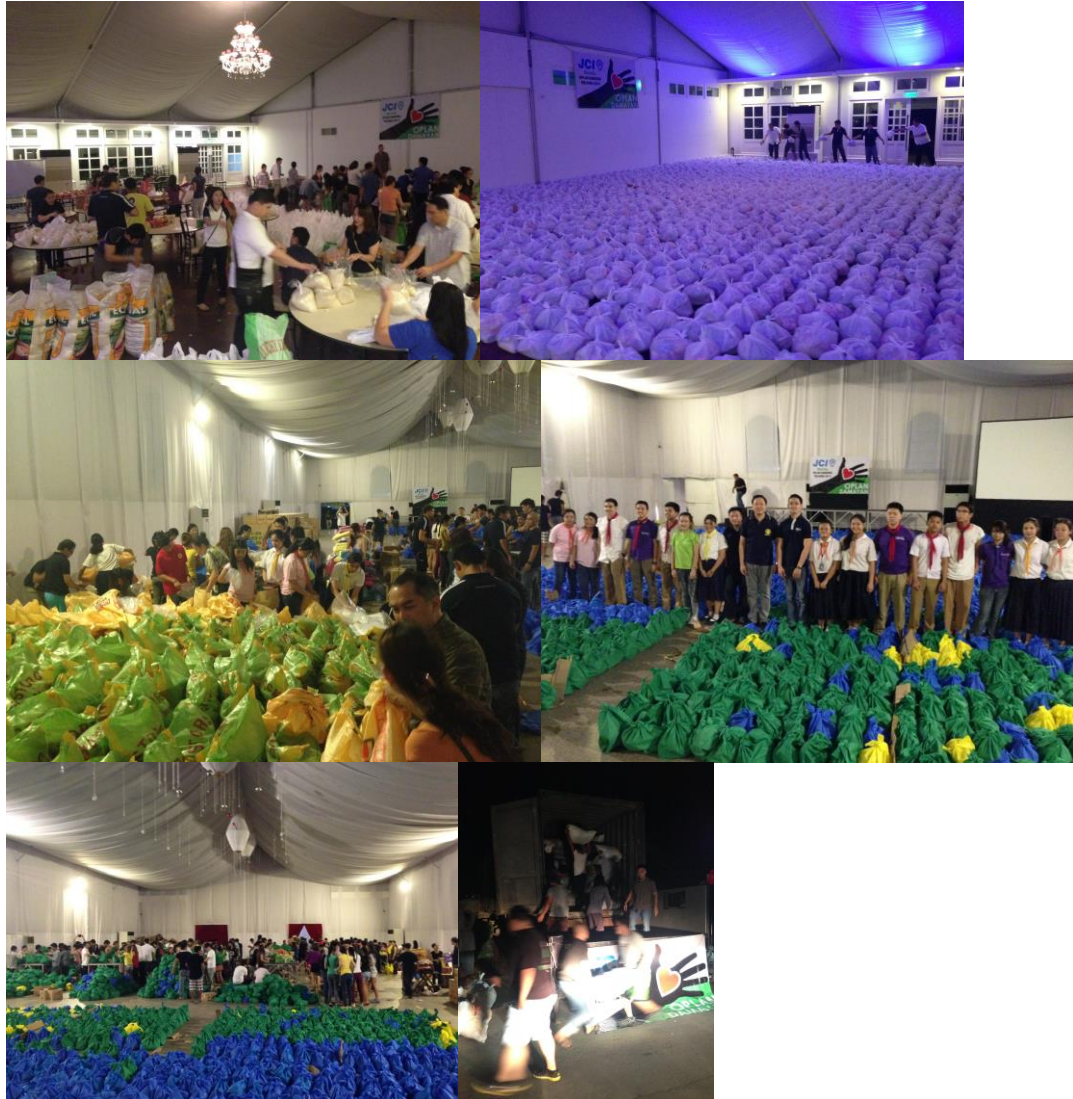

- 2. Distribute remaining 2,300+ relief packs in a container in Dir Gilbert Go's warehouse**
 - a. Samar
- 3. Support BJC project of Pio Granada for Bantayan Island**
 - a. 1 unit Fiberglass Rescue Boat c/o Habitat for Humanity
 - b. LPG-powered motorboats for fishermen
 - c. Fund-raising for Multi-Purpose Disaster Center
- 4. Allot P120,000 for Culion, Palawan** (Please see Appendix F)
 - a. Building materials for 8 fishing motorboats
- 5. Create long-term redevelopment plan in Tacloban**
 - a. Fundraising through future donations
 - b. Housing area coordinate w/ GK
