Seminar Topics:

On the first day of the seminar, Rugaas will discuss **Calming Signals** and share with us her insights on the fascinating world of communication between dogs, as well as dogs and their owners. She will also discuss **Stress in Dogs** (including stress in shelter or rescued dogs), its consequences, how stress affects dogs and what one can do to help dogs handle stressful situations.

On the second day, she will discuss **Problem Solving** for particular problems in dogs, particularly rescue or shelter dogs, **Loose Leash Walking** (theory and demonstration) and **Practical Work** (demonstrating hands on work with dogs using Rugaas's techniques).

Special Opportunity:

A limited number of 12 people will be selected *at no additional charge* to meet with Turid privately with their dogs to discuss special problems or issues. Those who are interested in this opportunity should submit a narrative on the registration form describing his/her dog and her problem. Turid will select the 12 she feels could most be helped in such a short consultation. (No additional charge for this service but the time per person is very limited—only maximum of perhaps 10 minutes.)

Dogs which participate in this consultation with Turid should either be willing to be quietly crated or able to wait in the car.
