## NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

1. No dogs are to be allowed in the Flower or Food Stand Buildings.
2. Exhibitors and handlers are responsible for clean conditions in and around their grooming area. Exhibitors are also responsible for clean-up at ringside, coming and going. Bring your own clean-up equipment.
3. Cereal Malt beverages, alcoholic beverages and narcotics of any kind are NOT allowed on the Fairgrounds.
4. No dogs will be allowed in restrooms or in the shower facilities. Wash areas are available.
5. Crating will not be allowed in the conformation or obedience buildings. Dogs must be removed immediately upon completion of judging.
6. Watch your dogs and do not let them urinate on inside walls to help eliminate odors and clean-up problems.
7. Videotaping by individuals for their own personal use will be allowed, but the Show Committee reserves the right to regulate the placement of cameras. Unauthorized commercial photographers will not be allowed.
8. Trophies must be claimed the day of the show.
9. Parking will be on a first come, first parked basis.
10. Concessions will be available on site.

**The Show Site will be available to exhibitors** at 7:00 p.m., Thursday, May 20, 2010.

**Dogs need to be present only for scheduled judging** and will be released if not needed for further judging.

**Dogs must be ready for judging.** Neither the club nor the Show Secretary will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of any Breed, Class or Sweepstakes judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class.

**Entry Fees shall not be refunded** in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee.

**There will be no refund for duplicate entries.**

**No entry shall be made** and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Any entry sent by special delivery or overnight mail must have the signature requirement waived. Any item requiring a signature will be returned unopened.

**Errors on Entry Blanks** – Owners are responsible for any errors in filling out entry forms, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellations of such entries after the published closing date. Entries and confirmations will be sent to 1<sup>st</sup> owner of record only.

**Entry form changes, additions or corrections** must be received in writing or by email prior to the closing of entries. Those received by telephone are NOT acceptable.

**Returned checks** do not constitute a valid entry fee, and a service charge of \$30.00 will be added for each returned check.

**All funds due from errors** in entry fee payments are due the day of the show before receiving an armband. No refunds for overpayment of fees will be given the day of the specialty. Refunds will be mailed within two weeks after the specialty date.

(Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
