SAFETY

1. Your new dog comes to you with 2 collars.
 - One has his/her ID tags on it, and should remain on them at all times.
 - The other is a martingale which has been custom made and fitted for your dog. We **STRONGLY** suggest both collars be used for at least the first 30 days. The martingale should be used for all walks as it is the safest way to restrain your dog.

PLEASE DO NOT REMOVE/REPLACE THESE COLLARS FOR THE FIRST 30 DAYS.

2. The first 30 days are a bonding time for you and your new best friend. It is expected your new dog will be nervous so please have patience. Being safe and comfortable should be the top priority. Practice walking your new dog inside a secure area first. Once comfortable, leashed walks outside can begin.

ALWAYS USE THE MARTINGALE COLLARS WITH A LEASH WHEN WALKING.

It is so easy for your new dog to become frightened and panic. While no safety restraint is 100% escape proof, most dogs are not able to slip out of a martingale.
