Pambansang Kilusan ng mga Samahang Magsasak (PAKISAMA) is a national peasant confederation and movement dedicated to the empowerment of the Filipino small farmers, fishers, rural women, youth, and indigenous peoples leading in the advocacy and implementation of sustainable agrarian and aquatic reform and rural development.

PAKISAMA's Fisheries Program works with our member fishing associations through the Philippines on organizational development, sustainable enterprise development, and advocacy as well as focusing on fisheries policy reform.

#### **Contract Description**

The Fisheries Program Campaigner will work closely with the Fisheries Program Manager to implement project and campaign objectives with specific ongoing projects as well as in the national advocacy strategy. The current contract is funded for 6 month full time and may be extended depending on funding availability. The Campaigner will be based at the National Office in Quezon City, but will be expected to travel to project sites.
