Salsabil Al-Dhadh (Spring of Arabic) is offering Multi levels Arabic courses during the Winter semester 2010. The courses are taught remotely with advanced teleconferencing tools enabling you to interact in real time with the teacher and other students, saving you time and efforts to reach the classroom. All courses are scheduled on Sundays morning for the students' convenience. If you miss some classes you are capable to view the video recording and catch all what happened in class.

The program is composed of ten levels (beginners to advanced) spread over three years with one class per week. The students spend in class one hour with the teacher, and do the homework during the week, and send the homework to teacher. The teacher correct it and send it back to students.

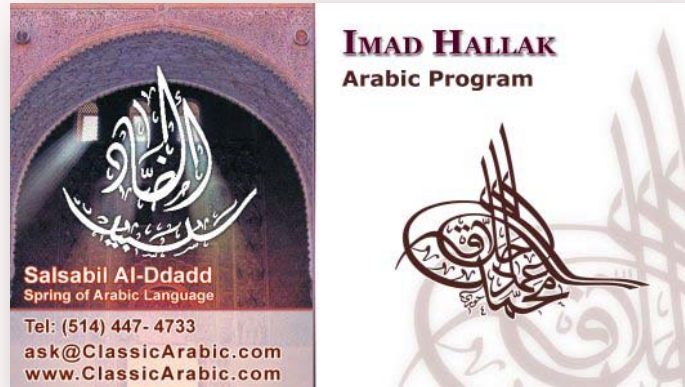

I believe money should not be a barrier that prevents the students from getting the knowledge. But on the other hand, it is not right also to look for having the knowledge for free, since professional education requires resources. In the Islamic history there was Awqaf paying for this purpose (Awqaf: are properties or capital generating monthly income halted for charity in a specific field specified by the donor of the property).



Since we do not have Awqaf today, the solution is not asking for free education, but it is by sponsoring collectively the poor students.

Solution 2: It is possible to sponsor the rest of the poor students by your union, nonprofit organization, wealthy person you know, or by sharing collectively (you and your friends) the fee of one student (104.00 Can\$/semester). Reports about the progress of the student can be provided to the sponsor regularly

Solution 3: If you have some money in your bank and you want to get rid of the accumulated forbidden interest (Riba) this is one way to get rid of it and make something useful.
