Natural nutrition, Traditional Chinese Veterinary Medicine (TCVM), acupuncture, herbal therapy, homeopathy, chiropractic, and physical rehabilitation are among the therapies veterinarians may be asked about in the course of their daily interaction with clients. Whether or not the veterinarian provides these services, it is crucial that he or she be knowledgeable about them in order to best advise inquiring clients. Information on these therapies is typically fairly limited in the traditional veterinary curriculum.


