

Board Resolution No. 26, Series 2017

Resolution: Call for Unity Among Filipino Mechanical Engineers

Whereas, Article III Section No. 23 of Republic Act No. 8495, Integration and Accreditation of Mechanical Engineers states that "AN integrated organization of mechanical engineers shall be created and accredited by the Board of Mechanical Engineering and the Professional Regulation.

Whereas, Article III Section No. 23 of Republic Act No. 8495, Integration and Accreditation of Mechanical Engineers expounds further that upon registration and payment of required fees PRC-registered Professional Mechanical Engineers, Mechanical Engineers, et. al. shall automatically become members of the integrated and accredited organization of mechanical engineers.

Whereas, the PSME POLICY MANUAL, CHAPTER 2 - PRINCIPLES AND OBJECTIVES OF THE SOCIETY under Section "2.1 GUIDING PRINCIPLES AND OBJECTIVES" accedes the above with the following sections and by referring to a single entity thru an adverb "the" describing a singular proper noun "PSME" or "Society": - 2.1.1 The Philippine Society of Mechanical Engineers subscribes and commits itself to uphold the Laws of the Republic of the Philippines, promote the PSME CREED and the objectives set forth in its Amended Articles of Incorporation and By-Laws. - 2.1.2 The PSME shall be governed by the Corporation Code of the Philippines as prescribed in Section 1.2 of the Amended By-laws. - 2.1.3 The Society endeavors to unite all practitioners for the exclusive purpose of advancing the arts and science of mechanical engineering, the allied arts and science and related human factors for the benefit of the general public as defined in the Articles of Incorporation. - 2.1.4 The Society shall provide a venue for its members to participate and contribute in the social, economic and industrial growth of the country.

Whereas, the CODE of MECHANICAL ENGINEERING ETHICS in the PHILIPPINES under section pertaining to "RELATIONS WITH COLLEAGUES AND ASSOCIATES" Rule 30. The mechanical engineer shall actively support "THE" duly accredited association with the end in view of enhancing the practice of the profession and discharging his public responsibilities as professional.

Whereas, the PSME CREED, recited by PSME Members in all of its official gatherings, strongly states the need of each Mechanical Engineer who takes oath to: - Affirm adherence to the Code of Ethics for Mechanical Engineers (noted on the 4th paragraph) - Be determined to support "ONE" organization that shall embrace the mechanical engineering profession Furthermore, the PSME Prayer calls out to all PSME members to serve to enable themselves to contribute to the enhancement of science and technology - It notes, "We pray for all Filipino Mechanical Engineers to work together as "ONE" in shaping the economic growth of our country."

Whereas, It was announced on 17 October 2016 on the official Professional Regulation Commission (PRC) website that in compliance with Republic Act No. 10912 entitled "An Act Mandating and Strengthening the Continuing Professional Development (CPD) Program for all Regulated Profession, Creating the Continuing Professional Development Council, and Appropriating Funds therefore, and for Other Related Purposes" the PRC will fully implement the requirement for CPD. The implementation of the said Act was noted to take place on the first quarter of 2017 which is this current quarter. In reference to the above excerpts from official guidelines adhered to by all PSME Chapters worldwide and official announcements by PRC, it has been voted and decided upon via majority decision by the GENERAL MEMBERSHIP of the Philippine Society of Mechanical Engineers CRSA Riyadh Chapter during its membership meeting held on 24 February 2017 at the White Palace Hotel, Riyadh, Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, to appeal from your good offices, the Professional Regulation Commission (PRC) - accreditor of the recognized Accredited Professional Organization (APO) for all professional degrees and the incumbent Board of Mechanical Engineers (BME) - esteemed 'fathers' of the Mechanical Engineering profession, to confirm the "ONE" PSME National Office hereby stated on the: - R.A. 8495 - PSME Policy Manual - Code of Ethics for Mechanical Engineers - PSME Creed - PSME Prayer Thereafter, our 820-strong General Membership shall support, remit our members' membership dues, provide needed financial support, course our official correspondences and pledge allegiance to the said "ONE" PSME National Office.
