Dear Chapter Presidents,



The **Government Procurement Reform Act (RA 9184)** in Section 12, Annex A of its Implementing Rules and Regulations, require implementors of infrastructure projects to **evaluate** the performance of their constructors using the NEDA-approved **Constructors Performance Evaluation System (CPES)**.

Under the government's "Build, Build, Build" Program, infrastructure projects will be accelerated and industries will be developed that will create jobs, catalyze economic growth & improve the lives of the Filipinos.

To date, there are only eighty-three (83) government agencies/offices that are using the CPES guidelines in their infrastructure projects with **2,050 active CPES evaluators**. The Philippine Domestic Construction Board (PDCB) of the Construction Industry Authority of the Philippines (CIAI) tasked to oversee the implementation of CPES has identified the need to **accredit more CPES evaluators** that can be tapped by government agencies as third-party evaluators to complement their requirements.

In connection to this, we are pleased to inform you that the Philippine Society of Mechanical Engineers (PSME) will be sponsoring a **Seminar-Workshop for the Accreditation of Constructors' Performance Evaluators** on **June 17-19, 2019** at Room 525, Don Lorenzo Building, 889 P. Paredes Street, Sampaloc, Manila. This training will boost awareness about CPES and increase the pool of second (government agency) and third-party evaluators from the private sector specifically the mechanical engineers. This training is also open to other disciplines/professions. There will be lectures, case studies and visit to a project site for the practicum/workshop session.

**We wish to invite your office to send participants to this course.** Attached is a copy of the Program & Modules Description. The seminar fee will be a modest amount of P7,500.00 for PSME Members, P8,250.00 for Non-Members/Other Professionals, Senior Citizen and Student rate for P6,000.00 only to cover meals & snacks for three (3) days, handouts, training certificate & other administrative costs.
