ACCREDITATION OF CONSTRUCTORS PERFORMANCE EVALUATORS (CPEs)

Presents the (1) minimum criteria and requirements for accreditation of agency's Constructors Performance Evaluators (CPEs); (2) filing, processing, and evaluation of applications; (3) accreditation process and its purpose; (4) terms and conditions for CPE accreditation; (5) implementation of CPE accreditation program; (6) the duties and functions of the CPES-Implementing Unit (IU); and (7) the responsibilities, privileges, and accountabilities of accredited-CPEs, as well as the proper attitude and behavior that government CPEs must observe and practice.

Module 3 CPES METHODOLOGY AND PROCESS FLOW

This module presents the different aspects/criteria and method of computing the rating for each project evaluation conducted during and upon completion of the projects, which include the unit-in-charge of CPES Implementation, the person/s who will undertake project evaluation, documents required during project evaluation, flow chart for functional deployment, and the procedures for accomplishing the CPES Evaluation Forms.

Module 4 SIMULATION ON THE APPLICATION OF CPES EVALUATION FORMS

Illustrates the step-by-step procedures in the application/use of CPES Evaluation Forms in a given project, and explains the method of computing the constructor's performance for each item of work for every project site visit.

Module 5 CPES INFORMATION NETWORKING AND DATABANKING

Explains the different uses of constructor's CPES ratings to government agencies concerned, the agency's Bids and Awards Committees (BACs), and other users of the data/information; the standard layout and contents of CPES reports for information sharing; the procedures for data generation, processing, and dissemination of CPES reports; and the role of DBM's Government Policy Procurement Board (GPPB).
