For over two decades Kasih Hospice has been at the frontlines of providing end of life care to the community. From a humble beginning with just a voluntary hospice doctor and a hospice nurse, we have grown today to a full time admin team of four, and a full time medical team of ten strong, serving more than 934 patients a year in 2018.

NGOs like ours have always worked quietly in the background, bringing complex but important issues into the light. We believe that as a hospice we play a key role as a driving force for development, to ensure healthy and optimal societies, and to help ease the burden of individual families. In light of changing demographics of this country and the increasing burden on our healthcare system, the role of hospice becomes more important than ever.

This year 2018 marks the 21st anniversary of Kasih Hospice Care Society. We want to acknowledge Losang Dragpa Buddhist Society which gave KHC the necessary support when we began in 1997 as its social service arm and later helped in the registration under ROS in 2005. We are proud of how far we've come, and optimistic about our path going into the future.

2018 was an eventful year. After seven and a half years of Pearl Thor's dedicated services, we transitioned to our new General Manager, Catherine Ooi. We also increased staff force, expanded our area of coverage, and the year saw a patient caseload increase of 30% over that of 2017. And whilst we had to say goodbye to some, we were happy to welcome others, namely Nurse Mervinder and Nurse Wong Li Jing who joined us in late 2018. And we also celebrated the return of our senior nurse Izza with her Post Basic Diploma in Palliative Care Nursing.

We had, and still have, to deal with many challenges and crises that cropped up every now and then, but we have always done our best to overcome them.

Kasih Hospice will always need your commitment and support.

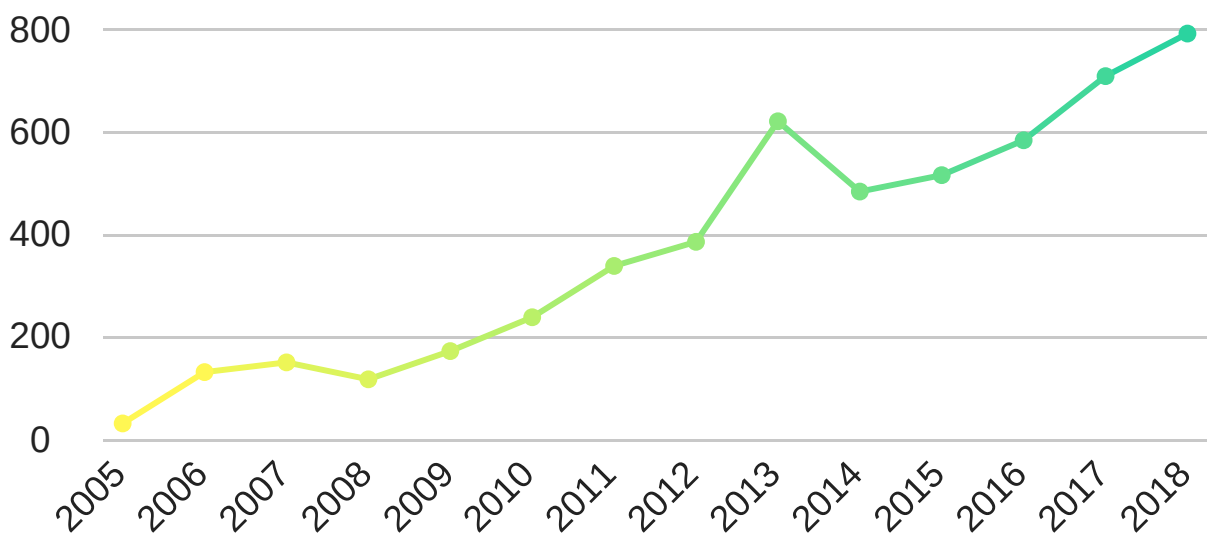

Patient Numbers



791 New Patients + 142 Old Patients

The Hospice saw 791 newly registered patients in the year ended 2018, recording an increase of 83 new patients compared with 2017. Together with a carry forward of 142 existing patients from 2017, this brought the total caseload for 2018 to a new record of 934 patients, or an increase of 30% over the previous year. Our total patients seen between 2005 to 2018 was 5262.

By ethnic percentage the largest group in 2018 was Chinese at 56%, followed by Malay 31%, Indian 12% and Others 1%.

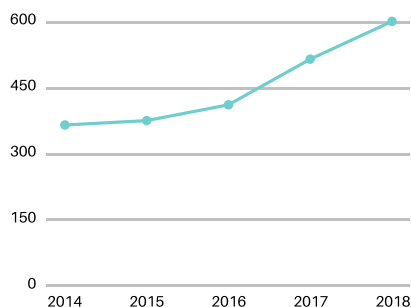
Patient Summary By Disease Type

Patient Disease Type is indicative of the categories of diseases that Kasih Hospice accepts. These fall broadly into 3 categories including:

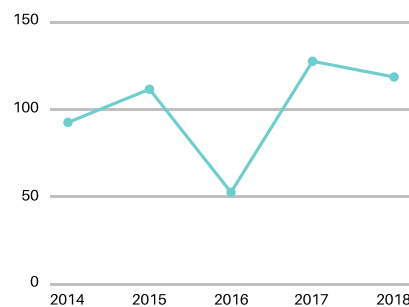
- All types of Cancers including carcinoma, sarcoma, melanoma, lymphoma, and leukemia.

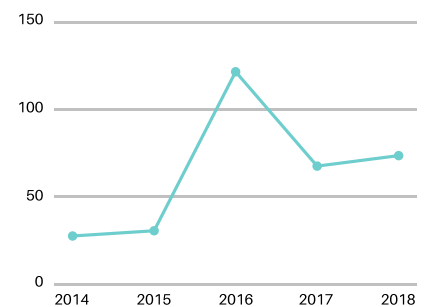

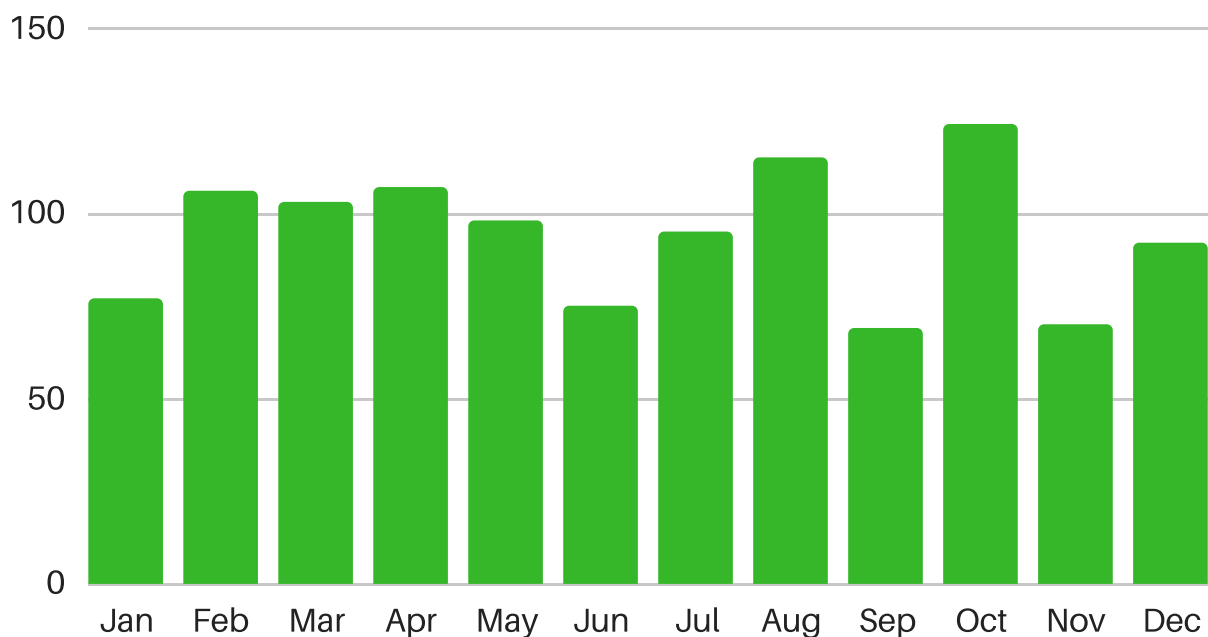


5 YEAR NON-CANCER

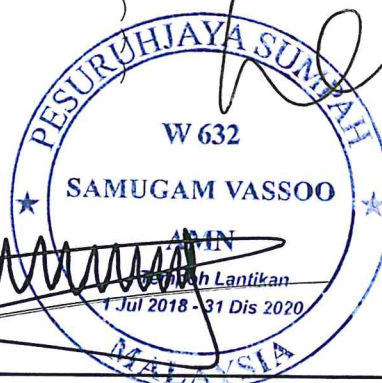



NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS
31ST DECEMBER 2018

1. GENERAL INFORMATION

The Society was established in 1997 as a community service arm of Losang Dragpa Buddhist Society. It was itself officially registered as a Society under the Societies Act on 4th March 2005. As a charitable organisation with a multi-disciplinary team of doctors, nurses and trained volunteers, it offers hospice services by providing medical, emotional and spiritual support to patients with advanced diseases such as cancer and end stage renal failure. All these services are provided free of charge. The Society is able to make a positive difference to those facing life-threatening illnesses and to their families too, through the kindness and generosity of sponsors and donors.

The Society is principally supported both operationally and financially by Yayasan Kasih (Company No. 791567-T), a company limited by guarantee and incorporated in October 2007 for the purpose of pursuing the principal and bigger role in the provision of hospice and related charitable activities. Accordingly, income received by the Society is donated to Yayasan Kasih as reimbursement of these funding expenses. The Society continues to receive donations on its own right which are onwardly donated to Yayasan Kasih.

2. MEMBERSHIP

As at 31st December 2018, the membership of the Society stood at 255 life members, 44 ordinary members and 5 associated members.

3. SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

(a) Basis of Accounting

The financial statements of the Society are prepared under the historical cost convention and in compliance with applicable approved accounting standards issued by the Malaysian Accounting Standards Board in all material aspects.

(b) Property, Plant and Equipment and Depreciation

Property, plant and equipment are stated at cost less accumulated depreciation and impairment losses.

Depreciation is calculated to write off the cost of the property, plant and equipment on a straight line basis over its expected useful lives. The annual rates are :-

(b) Property, Plant and Equipment and Depreciation (Cont'd)

When an indication of impairment exists, the carrying amount of the asset is assessed and written down immediately to its recoverable amount.

(c) Receivables

Known bad debts are written off and specific provision is made for any debts considered to be doubtful of collection.

(d) Cash and Cash Equivalents

The component of cash and cash equivalents is balances with bank.

(e) Provisions for Liabilities

Provisions are made when the Society has a present legal or constructive obligation as a result of past events, when it is possible that an outflow of resources will be recognised to settle the obligations and when a reliable estimate of the amount can be made.

Provisions are reviewed at each balance sheet date and adjusted to reflect the current year best estimate. Where the effect of the time value of money is material, the amount of a provision is the present value of the expenditure expected to be required to settle the obligation.

(f) Payables

Payables are stated at cost which is the fair value of the consideration to be paid in the future for goods and services rendered.

(g) Impairment of Assets

The carrying amounts of assets are reviewed at each balance sheet date to determine whether there is any indication of impairment. If such an indication exists, the asset's recoverable amount is estimated. The recoverable amount is the higher of an asset's net selling price and value in use. Value in use is measured using the discounted future cash flows expected to be generated from continuing use of the asset.

An impairment loss is recognised whenever the carrying amount of an asset exceeds its recoverable amount. The impairment loss is charged to the income statement immediately.

Any subsequent increase in recoverable amount of an asset is recognised as reversal of previous impairment loss and should not exceed the carrying amount that would have been determined (net of amortisation or depreciation, if applicable) had no impairment loss been previously recognised for the asset.
